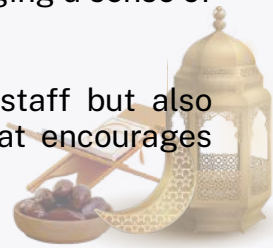
DISTRIBUTION OF BUBUR LAMBUK

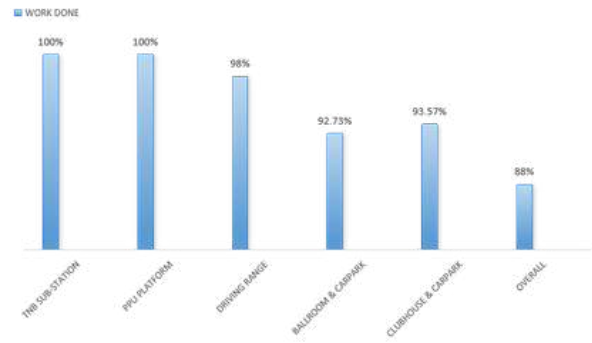


CLUBHOUSE, BALLROOM & DRIVING RANGE PROGRESS ANALYSIS (AS AT 31 MARCH 2026)



The redevelopment of Johor Golf & Country Club (JGCC) continues to advance in line with its planned schedule and has now reached 88% overall completion, reflecting steady and well-coordinated progress across all workstreams. Across the site, substantial progress has been achieved in both infrastructure and member-focused facilities.

JGCC REDEVELOPMENT PROGRESS AS AT 31 MARCH 2026



The Clubhouse & Carpark is currently at 93% completion, while the Ballroom & Carpark has reached 92%, with both areas undergoing final finishing works. These developments are taking shape as modern, functional spaces aimed at enhancing the overall member and guest experience.

In parallel, core infrastructure works have been successfully completed, establishing a reliable foundation for future operations. The Driving Range, now at 98% completion, is nearing readiness and is expected to be operational in the near term, offering upgraded practice facilities for members.

Overall, the project remains firmly on track as it progresses into its concluding stage. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the handover of the Clubhouse, Ballroom, and Driving Range is anticipated to be completed by the end of June 2026, marking a significant milestone in the club's transformation.

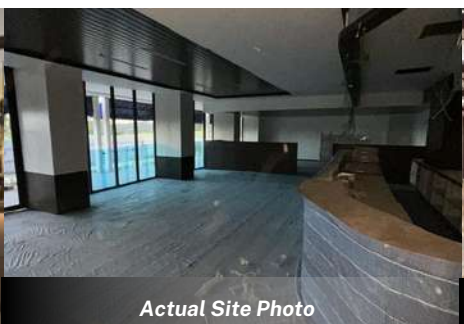

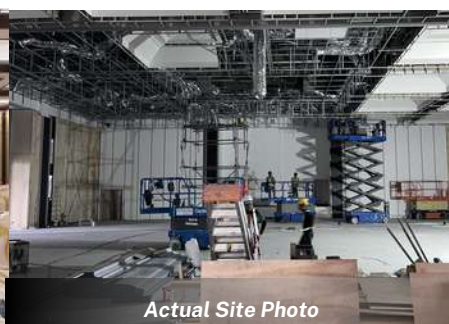
